

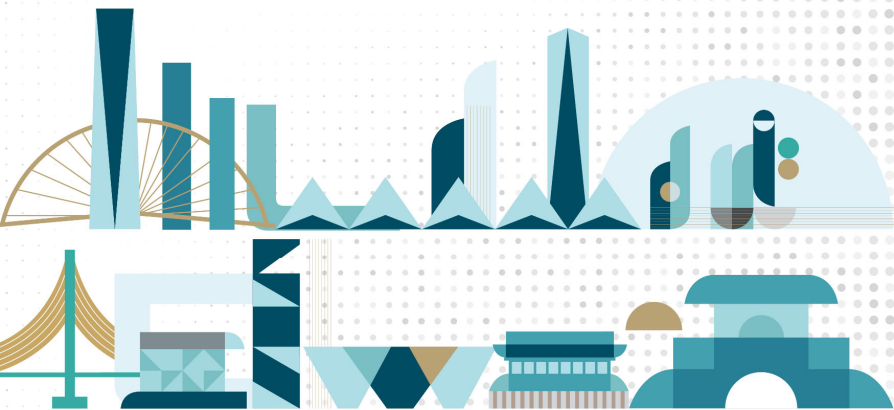

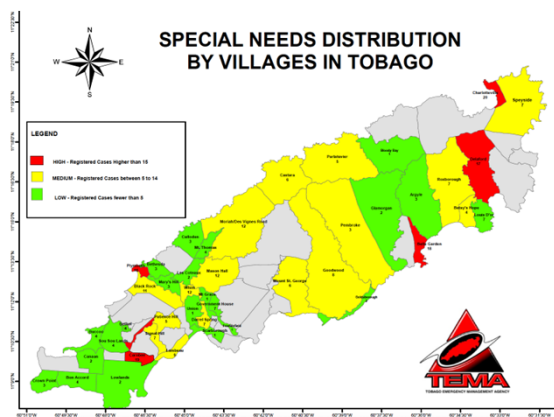

DRR EFFORTS IN TOBAGO

- Installation of CERT Centers (rural areas)
- Decentralization of critical resources via Community Preparedness Emergency Kits
- Special Needs Survey and Impact / Vulnerability Assessments
- Special needs mapping
- Establishment of the Disaster Management Committee
- Establishment of the Charlotteville Relief Centre
- Establishment of the Tobago Disaster Relief Warehouse
- Establishment of CERT 1000 Programme
- Establishment of the THA Disaster Relief Policy
- Establishment of Sargassum and other Hazard Specific Plans
- Installation of 4 strategically placed Multi-hazard Early Warning Systems

Remedial work in the Kings Bay and Castara Area, – Retaining Wall and Road Expansion

Increased Public Sensitization on Hazards, Effects, and Measure to adopt

Vulnerability and Capacity Assessments

Establishment and upkeep of Safe Shelters

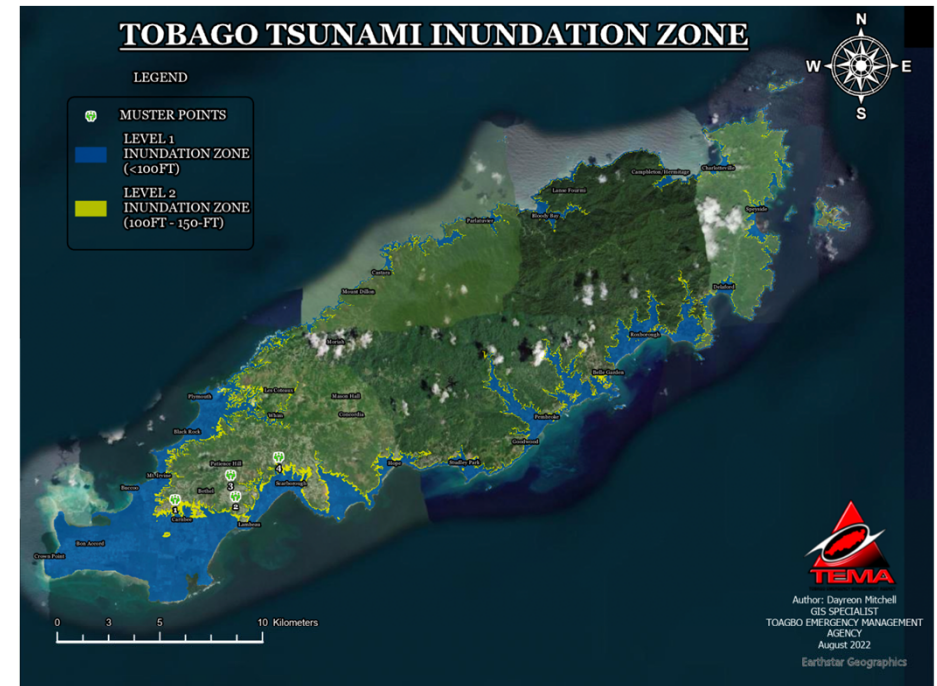
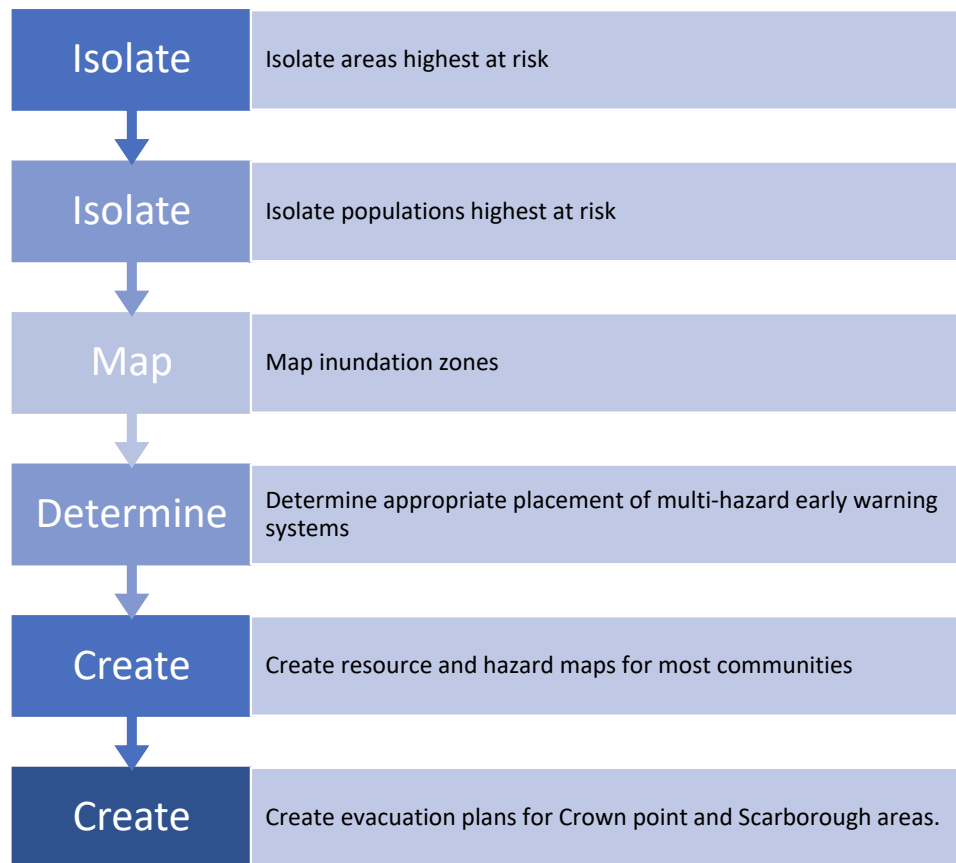

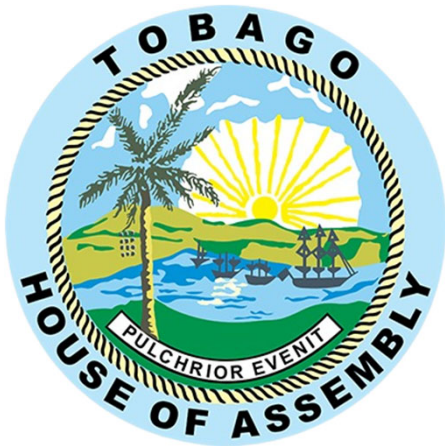


Based on Climate Information, Events and Trends, we were able to:
